Wellness – Taking Care of Your Skin

To complement your stunning new haircut and style, remember to pamper your skin for a radiant glow throughout the summer and fall months.

"Tourmaline is an energizing mineral that allows skin to function optimally by increasing 'energy' to skin and allowing the ingredients in products to penetrate as best as possible," says Krista Kiley, Aveda's Director of Spa Education. "At Aveda we believe in using botanically derived ingredients that are also sustainably harvested. We use plants because they have a synergistic effect on skin, allowing skin to function and recover as it should. Ingredients like pure jojoba are great because they act like skin's own natural sebum and the skin doesn't see it as a 'foreign' substance. They are great for cleansing and moisturizing even sensitive skin."

She adds that products requiring a vigorous scrub should be used in moderation, as excessive scrubbing may cause aging to the

skin. To prevent the appearance of aging, she emphasizes that applying sunscreen everyday is vital to all skin type sand complexions. "The sun has been proven to damage collagen and age the skin," she says. "Always use sunscreen as a preventative measure for healthy skin.

To nurture your skin from the inside and maintain that healthy glow, Kilev recommends an anti-inflammatory diet containing less sugar and refined carbohydrates, with lots of water to flush out impurities. "Get a regular facial, which can be preventative as well as corrective," she advises. "All facials are 'anti-aging' by nature. They increase blood flow and circulation and help remove toxins that build up and can cause skin eruptions and other challenges."
